AN ESTIMATE OF A BUDGET SUFFICIENT TO OPERATE CAS-CADE COUNTY FOR ONE YEAR

Care of Poor \$ 1000.

The amount of tax that would have to be levied on an estimated valuation of Cascade County of \$6,000,000. in order to raise \$49,157.96 (This would not include any road taxes.) Salaries of officers \$8050.

Cost operation offices 1457.96 Estimate of Budget 45550.

#### \$55057.96

Deducting probable income 5900.

\$49157.96

In order to raise \$49.157.96 it will be necessary to make a levy of 8.1 mills.

Add to this a 5 mill tax for roads, which would amount to \$30,000, all of which would be spent on roads within Cascade County and it would represent a total tax levy of 13.1 mills, as against 18.5 mills now in Clackamas County and would represent as much money for roads as Cascade County now receives.

According to law, the new county if created, will receive its pro-rata share of the assets of Clackamas County, which will amount to about 1-5 of the assets.

Jefferson County, Oregon, which two years ago was formed from Crook County, last year operated on a tax levy of 18.5 mills, with the parent County of Crook, maintaining a tax levy of 26.

Statistics generally indicate that the smaller counties of Oregon are operating on a lower tax levy than the larger counties. (These statistics were received this week from the office of the State Tax Commission.)

An estimate on the best of authority, states that the probable cost of transcribing the records for Cascade County, would not exceed \$2500.

The statistics and figures reproduced on this page are not the result of guess-work or rough estimates, but represent the labor of a number of experts, aided by the latest direct statistics from the State Tax Commission and carefully compared with other counties in Oregon, of similar size, valuation and population. It is the object of the County Division Mass Meeting on Friday night in Estacada, to further explain these figures, to answer all questions, and to furnish full information on all phases of the Cascade County movement.

The dinner will be served by the Ladies Aid of the M. E. Church and all voters residing within the boundaries of the the proposed Cascade County, both men and women are urged to attend the meeting and if possible enjoy the dinner first.
