In the name of the State of Oregon, you and each of you are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled cause on or before February 22, 1917, that being a date more than six weeks after the date of the first publication of this summons upon you, and if you fail to so appear and answer, for want thereof, plaintiffs will apply to the Court for the relief prayed for in their complaint: for Judgement against C. L. Gray and S. W. Harris in the sum of \$2350.00 with interest from December 11, 1913 at 6 per cent per annum, the further sum of \$200.00 as attorney's fees together with their costs and disbursements herein; that the mortgage recorded in Book 87 page 330 Mortgage Records of Clackamas County, Oregon, be decreed a first and valid lien on the following property in Clackamas County, Oregon; The NE 1-4 of the SE 1-4 of Sec. 28, T. 3 S., R. 4 E.
