Operations will begin at the Estacada Cooperative Cheese Association's plant on Friday morning, June 29th, with the milk collection on the Springwater side of the river beginning that day, and the balance of the routes starting the following morning.

The milk cans are already here and all patrons should be in readiness to begin sending in their milk on the first day. The Springwater route will be in charge of Mr. Zack of Dodge, with the Viola delivery being handled by Mr. Bateson. The milk collection in Eagle Creek, Currinsville and Garfield will be conducted by Ed Douglass and A. N. Orke of Eagle Creek and Herman Duus of Garfield.

Every dairyman in this community is urged to begin contributing milk, beginning with the first day's collection, for the success of the cheesery should date from its opening and a lack of milk at this time will prove a serious handicap.

Not only as a stimulus to home industries but as a broad business proposition, with good financial returns assured, every dairyman should become a patron of the Estacada Cheesery, for its success means much to the future development and prosperity of this community.

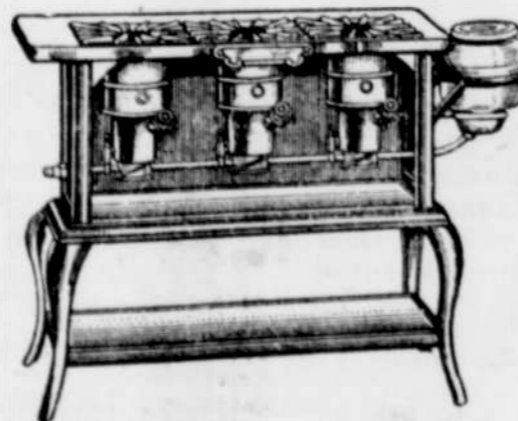
