Mr. and Mrs. Fred Moehnke of Logan were the week-end guests of Mr. and Mrs. Roy Douglass.

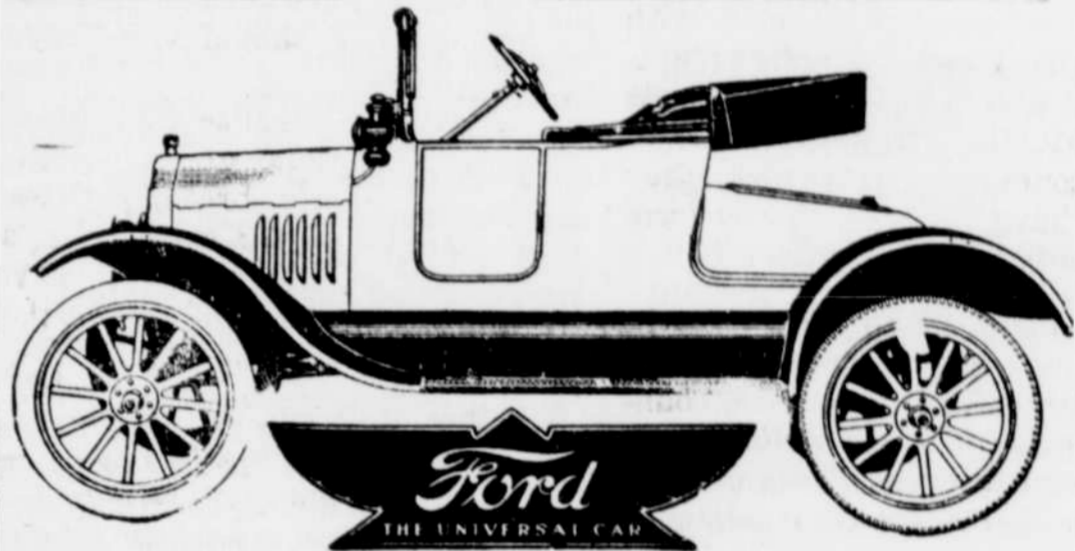
