Ames Kills Oak Grove Butte Cougar

It remained for A. G. Ames of Estacada, local Federal Hunter, to kill the famous old outlaw, known as the Oak Grove Butte cougar, which for six or seven years has defied all trappers and hunters.

Ames killed the brute last week, after it had been caught in a trap and then only after the animal had carried the trap with its heavy toggle for several miles and had climbed several big trees.

The cougar measured over nine feet from tip to tip and allowing for the time of year, the hide was in good condition.

Ames also killed three bob cats and almost caught a timber wolf, the latter animal having pulled his leg out of the trap after sacrificing considerable skin, hair and a couple of toes.

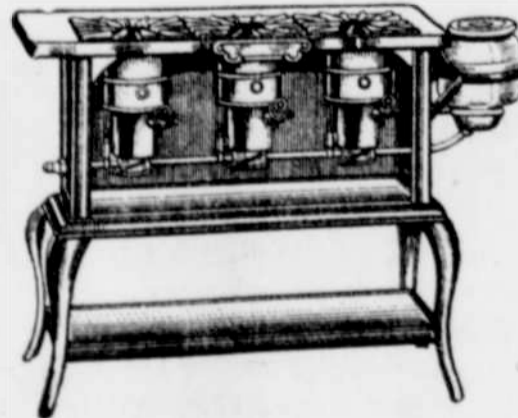
