Clackamas To Have Agricultural Agent

Clackamas County has now joined the ranks of the progressives and will have a county agricultural agent, stationed in Oregon City.

This emulation of other leading agricultural counties in this and other states, is the result of a conference held last Thursday between W. K. Newell of the Federal Food Commission, Paul V. Maris of the U. S. Dept. of Agriculture and the county court commissioners.

At present the expenses of the agent will be met by the government but the court announced Thursday that next year's budget would include an item of \$1500, which the taxpayers would be asked to authorize for the expense of the work. This amount will have \$3500 added to it by the government.
