## A THANK YOU FROM THE MANAGEMENT

We take this means of thanking our many customers for their hearty response to our circular letter sent out September 1st, outlining our future policy in the handling of our charge accounts, which in brief was "All Charge Accounts Due 10th Of Month Following Purchase," but where circumstances were such that the customer could not pay promptly by the 10th, they were given the option of signing a thirty day Trade Acceptance at 6%. We are glad that thus far but one party has taken exception to these terms. We appreciate all of our customers and desire to accomodate them as far as we can, but as stated in our circular letter, circumstances over which we have no control makes it necessary to discontinue every account that does not comply with our terms. Think it over and see if you dont think we are pretty liberal if we carry you for thirty or forty days, and then give you an additional thirty days at only 6%. We want to serve you and at the same time preserve ourselves.

## DRIED BEET PULP

We have been having several calls recently for Dried Beet Pulp, and have been earnestly endeavoring to buy sufficient for our needs, but thus far we have been able to buy but two cars, which at the present time looks as though it would be our entire supply for the season, whereas last year we handled eight cars.

One of these cars should arrive within the next week and we are now taking orders subject to the arrival of the car, at \$40 per ton spot cash at time of delivery, as this commodity comes to us with sight draft which must be paid before the car is unloaded. Remember but two cars for the season and one of these partly sold. If you want beet pulp for your dairy cows, order now. First come—first served.

## WHAT HAVE YOU TO SELL

We are endeavoring daily to enlarge our buying facilities so that we can handle anything that comes from the farm.
