Pastor Drill Returns To School

Pastor Guy Drill of the Christian Church left this week, accompanied by Mrs. Drill, for Eugene, where he will continue his studies at the Eugene Bible University, which is associated with the University of Oregon.

Mr. Drill had expected to have begun his studies the first of the month, but a severe attack of sciatic rheumatism delayed his departure.

During his course at the University, Mr. Drill will preach in Estacada every other Sunday, officiating the alternate Sunday's at Coberg, Oregon.

Walter Givens of Estacada is now conducting successful revival services each night at the Rodney Avenue Christian Church in Portland and in the Fall expects to continue the work at Coberg, in conjunction with Pastor Drill.

We note that County Agriculturalist Werner is investigating the advisability of seeding over several thousands of acres of burned over land in the mountains of this county, for pasture.
