Steel Head Fishing Good

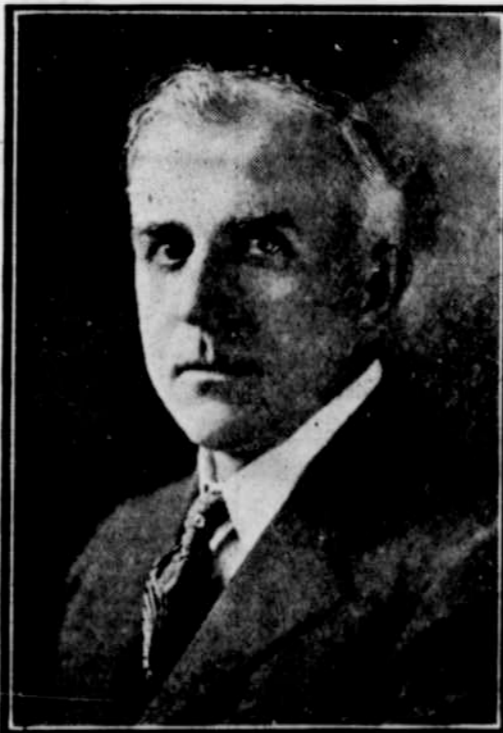
