The time has again arrived for making out your income tax returns. The law provides that all returns must be in the office of the Collector of Internal Revenue at Portland, on or before

March 15th, 1920. Those failing to comply with the law are subject to heavy penalties.

All tax payers are urged to make out their returns at once, thereby avoiding the rush at the last hour.

For the purpose of assisting tax payers of Clackamas County in making up their Income Tax return for 1919, Deputy Collectors Collins & Gayot from the Internal Revenue office will be at the following places on dates given below:

Canby, Feb. 5th to 7th, inc. 1920

Molalla, Feb. 5th to 7th inc. 1920  
Estacada, Feb. 16, and 17, 1920  
Oregon City, March 3, to 6, 1920

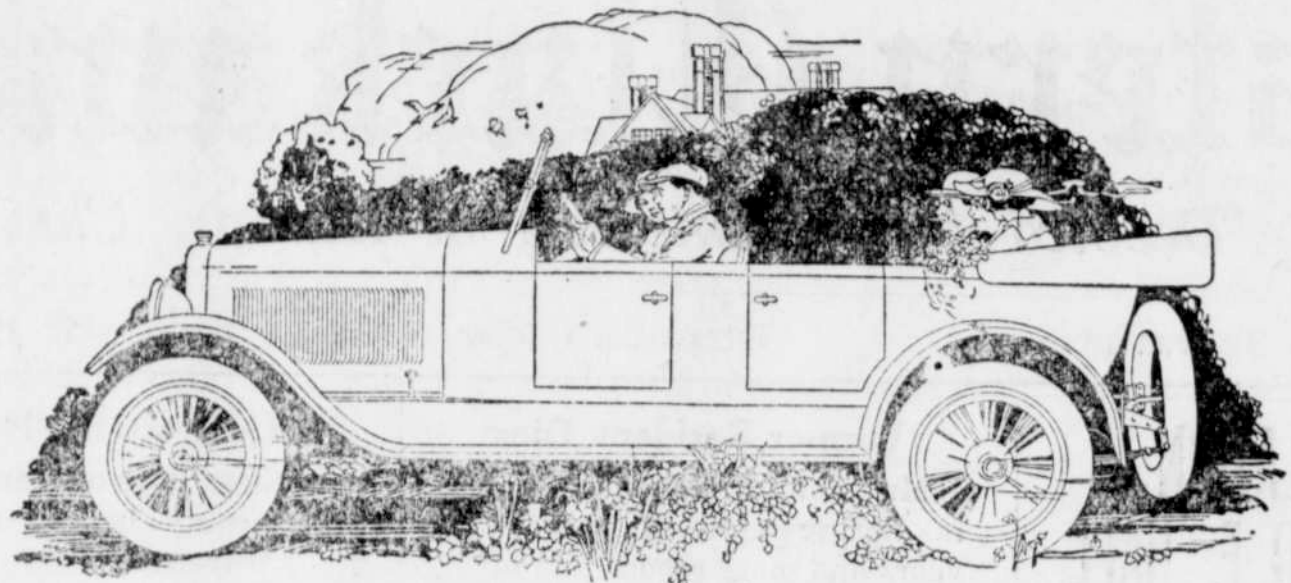
