

RESOLUTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ESTACADA, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, that the following proposed amendments to the charter of said City be and the same hereby are proposed for submission to the legal voters of said City for their adoption or rejection at the special city election to be held on the 21st day of August, 1920, as in this resolution provided:

AN ACT.

To amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the City of Estacada, in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon", filed in the office of the Secretary of State January 31, 1905, and to amend all acts amending said act subsequently enacted by the Legislative Assembly or by vote of the people.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ESTACADA that an act entitled "An act to incorporate the City of Estacada, in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon", filed in the office of the Secretary of State January 31, 1905, and all acts amending said act subsequently enacted by the Legislative Assembly or by vote of the people be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 43 to read as follows:

Section 43. (a) For the purpose of procuring funds to retire and redeem the City of Estacada street and Sewer bonds in the principal sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) dated June 1, 1910, payable June 1, 1920, in denominations of five hundred dollars (\$500) each and numbered 1 to 10 inclusive, the Council is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and dispose of general obligation bonds of said City in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), said bonds to be in denominations of five hundred dollars (\$500) each, numbered 1 to 10 inclusive, to be dated July 1, 1920, and to mature serially in numerical order at the rate of \$500 per annum on the first days of July in each of the years 1921 to 1930 inclusive, said bonds to be signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Recorder under the corporate seal of the City, and to have attached thereto semi-annual interest coupons bearing the engraved fac-simile signatures of the Mayor and Recorder, whereby the City shall be held in substance and effect to undertake and promise to pay to the bearer of each of said bonds at maturity thereof the sum therein named in gold coin of the United States of the present standard of value with interest thereon in like gold coin at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, payable semi-annually, each of said bonds to be a direct general obligation of the City of Estacada and to be known as "City of Estacada Refunding Bonds", the principal of and the interest on said bonds to be payable at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Oregon in New York City.

(b) The purchaser of the aforesaid bonds shall in no way be required to see to the proper application of the purchase money therefor.

(c) The debt limitations contained in the charter of said City shall not apply to the bonds hereby authorized.

(d) The Council shall each year at the time of making the annual tax levy for City purposes include in such levy a sum sufficient to pay interest due on the outstanding bonds of this issue and to retire the principal thereof at maturity.

RESOLVED FURTHER that this resolution for proposed charter amendments submitted to the voters by the Council be filed with the Recorder of the City of Estacada, for submission to the legal voters of said City, for their rejection or approval to be voted upon at a special election to be held as herein provided:

RESOLVED FURTHER that the Council deems it advisable and does hereby and herein call and make necessary provision for the holding of a special election which shall be and hereby is called to be held on the 21st day of August, 1920, between the legal voting hours on said date, and that said time be and the same hereby is designated as the time for holding said special election, and the City Hall in said City is hereby designated as the polling place therefor,

and the following named persons are hereby designated and appointed as and for the judges and clerks of said election, to-wit: Lucy M. Reed, Susie Sarver, Elizabeth M. Sparks, Judges Eva Saling, Rose Bartholomew, clerks.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that for the hereinabove proposed charter amendments, the following ballot title be and the same hereby is adopted, to-wit:

Charter Amendments Submitted to the Voters by the Council.

AN ACT.

To amend an act entitled "An Act to incorporate the City of Estacada, in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon", filed in the office of the Secretary of State January 31, 1905, by adding thereto Section 43 providing for the issuance and sale of \$5,000 Refunding bonds to redeem a like amount of City street and sewer bonds now due and providing for a tax levy to pay principal and interest thereon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Recorder be and he is hereby instructed to publish the hereinabove proposed charter amendments submitted to the voters by the Council in the manner provided by law, that is to say, by publication of this resolution in full for two consecutive publications within twenty days immediately preceding said special election in the Eastern Clackamas News same being a newspaper published in the City of Estacada and hereby designated for said purpose.
