(b) The purchaser of the aforesaid bonds shall in no way be required to see to the proper application of the purchase money therefor.

(c) The debt limitations contained in the charter of said City shall not apply to the bonds hereby authorized.

(d) The Council shall each year at the time of making the annual tax levy for City purposes include in such levy a sum sufficient to pay interest due on the outstanding bonds of this issue and to retire the principal thereof at maturity.
