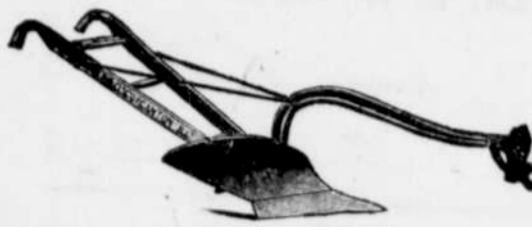

Dr. R. G. McCall, health officer, reports that for district 69 there were during 1920, 42 births, being equally divided between boys and girls. The same period showed 22 deaths, all elderly people, except three in infancy. Contagious diseases have been few, including meningitis, small-pox and one case of diphtheria. Dr. McCall has been reappointed and still holds the position of register of vital statistics for this district.
