Fire Prevention Week

By proclamation of the gover-By proclamation of the gover-nor the week of October 7 to 14 E. Y. STONE, Estacada, Rt. 3. has been set aside as fire prevention week. Mayors, fire chiefs, schools and civic organizations are urged to undertake plans which will make the week truly effective. The object is primarily to educate the children and people generally in the need of greater care to prevent fires at all times and to improve means and methods of fire fighting and strain of White Leghorn pullets fire protection.

This means the wiping out of needed resources at the rate of about \$1,370,000 a day, in addition to the destruction of 48 lives

"In our own state, during the five years ended with 1920, our fire waste came to the great total of \$10,395,286, a sum that would[build 2,079 \$5,000 homes or many miles of good roads. Thus it is evident that we are paying our full share of the tax levied by carelessness and ignorance in handling fire hazards.

"Since most fires are preventable, the devastation by burning that takes place day after day, is largely unnecessary. It goes without saying that every effort should be made to relieve the people of the self-imposed burden represented by preventable
