OBITUARY

Joel Baker Bowman was born at Savannah, Missouri, May 18th, 1844, and departed this life Saturday, August 22, at 9:30 p. m. Aged eighty-one years, three months and four days.

At the age of 18 he volunteered for service in the Civil war, where he served two years and 10 months. In 1873 he came with his family to Portland, Oregon, and 26 years later they moved from Portland to Garfield district near Estacada, where he resided for over 24 years. Two years ago he retired and came to Estacada, where he resided until the time of his death.

Mr. Bowman was a faithful member of the Methodist church for over 50 years. Mrs. Bowman preceded him in death 15 years ago the 10th of September, leaving a family of small children which Mr. Bowman kept together and cared for as only a Christian father could do. He was the father of 11 children, all living but two; a girl died in infancy and Joel B., Jr., who died in the U. S. navy in 1920.

Funeral services were conducted at the Methodist church Tuesday afternoon, the pastor, Ira F. Rankin, delivering the funeral sermon from the text: "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord"—Rev. 14:13.

Prayer was offered by Rev. B. F. Clay, pastor of the Disciples church. Miss Dillon sweetly sang: "Palms of Victory," "Abide With Me," and "My Hope Is Built."

Interment was made in Mt. Zion cemetery under direction of Joseph E. Gates of Gresham.
