Under Mr. Grant's direction the phonographic address plan worked out smoothly to complete success.

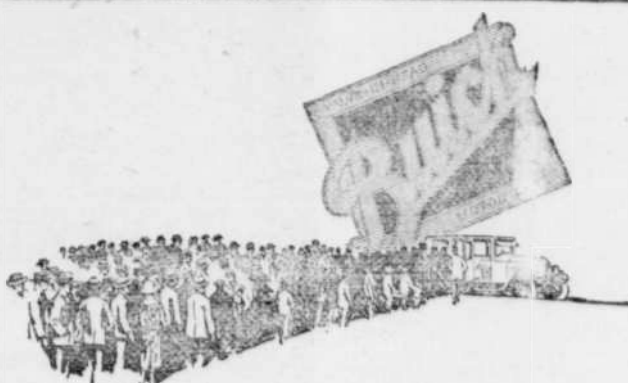
