GRANGE WINS IN WISCONSIN.

Victorious in its Fight for Anti-Oleomargarine Legislation.

In Wisconsin the grange has vigorously backed the anti-oleomargarine law, which becomes effective at once, following its passage by the legislature and the signature of Governor Bialine. This enactment is expected to prevent the flooding of the state with oleo and is one of the most drastic measures for the benefit of dairymen that has ever been passed in any state. The grange of the country, both national and state, has a long record of accomplishment for dairy protective laws and in the prohibition of the sale of butter substitutes except when plainly marked as such.
