These booklets give estimates on cost, blue prints, how to mix and nuch general information.

Oregon, Seed Potato State .-- Unfor the present seed certification law, Oregon is jumping to the front as a seed potato state, and many farmers in different sections are raising inspected stock to be certified to by the O.A.C. Growers Holding Wheat .- Wheat shipments from the ranches to the Portland terminals are the lowest to date for many years, only about 20 per cent having been shipped. Farmers appear to be holding their grain for better prices.

Fall cleanup of the farm, home garden and orchard will materially reduce the insect pests of the following season. Cutworms, grassnoppers and root maggots are detroyed by fall plowing and burning of the fence rows and ditch banks. San Jose scale, tent caterpillars, tree crickets, aphids, leaf hoppers and cicadas are destroyed by burning the prunings from the orchard, brush and bramble fruits. Gathering up and destroying crop remnants, litter, rubbish and weeds in the home garden destroy the hibernating places of such insects as the cucumber beetle and asparagus bee-

The best type of fat lamb weighs about 80 pounds, and those much heavier will not bring so good a price on the market. The cut in price is usually pretty heavy on ambs that run up to 90 to 100 pounds, regardless of quality. By feeding the fattening lambs one pound of grain a day and all the alfalfa they will eat, they should gain one pound every three to four

Strawberry crown borers in Oregon are controlled by burning the infested plants in the fall, advises the experiment station. Old plantings serve as breeding grounds for the moths unless plowed up, exposing the plants to the winter cold. New plantings are best located as far away as possible from the old plantings,

Drainage systems are examined and outlets opened at this time of the year on well managed Oregon farms. Before heavy rains and after fall seeding, dead furrows and surface runs are cleaned out. A plow or a steel V type ditcher is suitable for clearing weeds, rubbish and silt out of small surface ditches.

Small surface ditches on wet Oregon fields are best placed so they can be dispensed with and finally replaced with underground drains.
