

"Regulating" Grain Gambling.
The newspapers state that the Chicago Board of Trade has agreed to the plans of Secretary of Agriculture Jardine, and that wheat gambling will be restricted. A regulation has been adopted that the board directors may place a limit on how high or low prices may go, and that "heavy penalties are provided for anyone buying or selling above or below the limit set by the directors." State Senator Aspet Spence thinks that this is rather of a remarkable proposition on the part of the government. "Supposing that a gambling house in Portland would be given a license to play poker if the ante was restricted to two-bits, and if any of the boys over the limit they would be punished. This is about the substance of the 'regulation' put on the Chicago Board of Trade, as I see it," he says. "Gambling on grain in Chicago is either all right or all wrong—limiting the stakes doesn't change it."

What I Voted in Morrow County.
Movement of wheat from eastern Oregon to Portland terminals this fall has been very slow in comparison with former seasons. Farmers apparently holding back for higher prices. Actual prices to growers around Heppner, as reported to the state market agent's office, ranged from \$1.20 to \$1.25, net, for Bluestem; C125 and Forty-fold \$1.25 to \$1.28; Turkey Red \$1.15 to \$1.25. These differences were mostly on grades, and wheat of good test weight and grade would run closer in price. For instance, the \$1.15 lot of Turkey Red weighed 32 pounds to the bushel.
