

#### GOOD THINGS TO EAT

WE ALL have some recipes which we enjoy preparing again and again. One of these is a good cooky recipe, for in most homes the cooky jar is a very important part of the household equipment, and it is wise to keep it well stocked.

Martha's Cookies.

Make a rich biscuit dough, roll out and cover with one cupful of chopped apples well sugared and flavored with either cinnamon or nutmeg. Bake onehalf hour, then pour over some cranberry sauce and bake ten minutes

Chocolate Pudding.

Beat one egg, add one-half cupful of sugar and one cupful of milk pour over one and one-half cupfuls of flour sifted with three teaspoonfuls of baking powder; when well blended add two squares of chocolate, melted, a pinch of salt. Steam one and one-half own.


