BE CAREFUL WITH FIRE

During this dry, hot weather, there is more danger than ever of fire, and especially so in the forests. District Forest Ranger A. W. Armstrong has issued a warning to all entering the reserve to be careful. So far there have been no forest fires in this district, and extreme precautionary measures are being taken at this time by the men guarding and protecting the forests.

Fire starting now would be hard to control and fire fighting during hot weather is not a pleasant job. Use all the care possible, and warn others to do likewise. In case of discovering a fire try to put it out and notify the rangers as quickly as possible.

The forest service men are in readiness to depart at a moment's notice. The lookout men are stationed in such positions that a fire breaking out anywhere in the district can be observed, unless vision is shut off by fog or smoke, and with the telephone network as it now is, makes it possible to spread the alarm to all parts of the district within a minute or two.

A big forest fire now would do untold damage, and every good citizen will do everything within his power to keep down this destructive demon, and protect the forests—national, state or private.

Help preserve the vacation grounds, the growing timber and wild life by being careful with fire at all times and especially so during this hot, dry weather.
