## Predicts Good Business Year

Charles L. Jacobson vice president in charge of sales, Chrysler Sales Division, Chrysler corporation is looking forward to another big year for the automotive industry.

outlook for meat animals for marketing during the 1940-41 season appears more favorable than the long-time prospect," as "consumer demand for meats during the 1939-40 season and the total quantity of livestock to be marketed is expected to be smaller."

It was further pointed out in the college statement on the meat animal outlook that the reduction in the meat supply during the 1940-41 marketing year would be due practically to fewer pigs. The supply of hogs for the 1939-40 season was the greatest in five years following the largest pig crop on record in 1939.

The pig crop of 1939 was estimated at 86 million head. In 1940 the pig crop was reduced to 77 million head and a considerable further reduction in 1941 was indicated by the pig crop report.

The effect on meat supplies of the secretary's advice to farmers to market more beef instead of continuing to hold back large numbers of cattle for breeding stock is also problematical. The soundness of this suggestion is not questioned says Prof. Briethaupt but if followed extensively there will be more meat on the market than appeared probable last September.

On the other hand consumer demand for meat will probably be even stronger than was anticipated last fall indicating that meat prices may be expected to hold up well until the supply produced and imported becomes materially greater or consumer purchasing power drops.

90 percent credit offset must be secured and employers entitled to exemption must give written notice of withdrawal before January 31.

More than \$1,500,000 in fourth quarter tax payments is expected this month from 10,500 employers of four or more workers.

After paying the state tax on 1940 payroll about 5000 employers of eight or more may deduct under Chapter IX of the Internal Revenue Code 90 percent of the 3 percent unemployment tax assessed by the federal government. Both payments must be completed this month to secure full tax credit offset.

Employers continue subject to the tax until they complete a calendar year without employing four or more workers in any quarter during which their payroll runs over \$500. In all cases written notice of withdrawal may be made only in January.

"If an employer is in doubt about coverage he should consult an auditor or other representative of the commission," declared administrator Silas Gaiser. "If notice is not given in writing during this 30-day period the law provides the employer must wait until next year to escape the tax."
