Forest Fire Camp at OSC is Opened for Second Year

Training in the control of forest fires has started again at Corvallis for the second year under a cooperative program between the NYA and school of forestry with the aid of state and forest agencies. The "red hat" central camp has been opened six miles northeast of Corvallis on the McDonald forest with an initial enrollment of 46.

Other young men are being sought for the training with anyone eligible between the ages of 17 and 24 who is in need of work and is interested in receiving training in this type of forest conservation. Many of the young men now starting their training will receive responsible positions with the forest protective agencies yet this summer according to school of forestry officials.

Men will receive immediate training in the use of the fire finder, radio and other fire equipment after which they will be eligible for placement as forest guards. Many of the regularly trained foresters this year have been taken into defense positions.

In addition to the central camp side camps will be located near the Santiam pass at Hoodoo ski lodge, at Campus mountain near Roseburg and a third in Clatsop county. When out on fire duty the men receive regular wages.

Disaster Personnel is Named

The Disaster Relief program contemplates the assistance of the American Legion and its individual members in major disasters as well as minor disasters which cannot be controlled and may develop into a major calamity. It does not include participation in strike-breaking activities. The term "disaster" will be construed to include floods, fire, earthquakes, pestilence, tornadoes, air raids and other emergencies which may threaten the loss of life and destruction of property and which cannot be controlled by public authorities when the disaster occurs.

The Post Disaster relief company consists of:

1 Company Commander, responsible to the post commander and executive committee or any higher authority in charge. He is absolutely in supreme command during time of mobilization unless removed by the post executive committee for cause. Cooperates entirely with local or

military authority and American Red Cross.

2 Chief of Staff. Is the executive officer of the company in charge of headquarters.

3 Plans and Training Officer. Supervises and secures expert training for each platoon and rates efficiency of all platoons and squads.

4 Judge Advocate. Rules on all legal matters and is responsible for discipline of the company.

5 Personnel Assignment Officer. Makes individual assignments to platoons but the platoon chiefs assign individuals to squads. He is responsible for selection of all man power.

6 Finance Officer. Approves all expenditures of post money. Renders accounting of all expenditures to Red Cross. Keeps financial statements of the entire relief operation.

7 Civil Advisor. Can be a non-Legion member who acts as a go-between in matters to non-veteran population. He coordinates activities with civil authorities and the American Red Cross.
