#### Nutrition Field Vital to Health and Efficiency

Vigorous organized action to make the present knowledge of nutrition serve the country in this emergency period and afterward is expected to follow the big national nutrition congress for defense reports Dean Ava B. Milan of Oregon state college who is chairman of the Oregon committee.

Dean Mhan who was one of several delegates to the congress from the Oregon committee reports that emphasis was placed on action rather than words through the conference and that federal officials declared that neither the national meeting nor the state groups are places "for those who merely want to ride."

An adequate daily diet from the standpoint of nutrition and personal satisfaction is directly linked with health, efficiency and morals among the armed forces, defense workers and the civilian population as a whole it was emphasized. In this connection some pointed out that proper regard for nutrition need not be made a technical mystery nor a burden to the individual or family, for after all the best results are obtained when "eating is fun" as one speaker said.

At the same time scientists and medical men in the congress called attention to the extreme importance of diet in everyday life. As one said, there are two kinds of hunger, hollow and hidden and the hidden hunger from lack of necessary food elements has tremendous indirect bearing on physical and mental health and general morals. The immediate problem some high officials stated is to translate America's huge food surpluses into improved diets for the greatest possible number of people.

Dean Milan reports that the Oregon committee although organized after those in many other states is far ahead in its work as any but a few. The Texas, Tennessee and Ohio committees are further advanced and from them she obtained valuable suggestions. The next meeting of the state committee will be July 9 at Corvallis.
