Unsuccessful deer hunters will have another chance to fill their tags this coming weekend.

According to the Oregon Game Commission, on Nov. 26 and 27, nimrods with unused deer tags will be allowed to hunt for one deer of either sex throughout the agricultural areas of the Willamette valley.

Hunters are cautioned that unlike the general either sex season in the Willamette valley when extensive private timberlands were open, the November 26 and 27 hunt is limited to within one mile of established agricultural lands.

Open areas are: Established agricultural lands and adjacent areas within one mile in Clackamas, Columbia, Marion, Multnomah, Washington, Yamhill, Polk, Benton, Linn, and Lane counties.

The bag limit is one deer of either sex for those hunters possessing an unused deer tag.

County beef, dairy, sheep and swine producers are invited to attend a three-day veterinary school to be held at the Fairgrounds, Canby, December 6, 7, and 8, according to E. F. Barger, Clackamas County Livestock association president, sponsor of the activity. Each meeting starts at 1:00 PM.

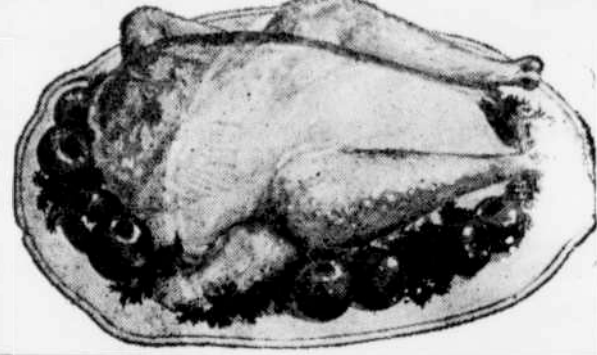
