'SLOW DOWN AND LIVE' SAYS HOLMES
 Governor Robert D. Holmes today urged state-wide support for the 'Slow Down And Live' traffic safety campaign, which begins Memorial Day, and said the state's goal will be to keep traffic deaths below 100 during the next three months.
 "If we can achieve this goal," he said, "we will be doing something we have managed to do only twice in the past five years."
 Last year 115 people died in traffic accidents during June, July and August. Death counts for other recent summers were 123 in 1955; 99 in 1954; 98 in 1953 and 141 in 1952.
 "The mere fact that the traffic accident problem has become so serious that the best we can realistically hope for is no more than 100 deaths in a three-month period should be enough to stir greater public support for this program," said Governor Holmes.

Emphasis this year will again be on enforcement, centering around the campaign's central theme: reduction of violations associated with excessive speed, speed too fast for conditions, improper passing, following too closely and failure to yield right of way.
 Oregon's program is headed by the state traffic safety commission, an agency composed of nine departments with responsibilities in the safety field.
FARM PRICES GO UP—EXCEPT IN OREGON
 Prices paid Oregon farmers slipped slightly during April while farm prices over the nation continued upward, reports Mrs. Elvera Horrell, extension agricultural economist at Oregon State College.
 Lower prices for poultry and grains other than wheat were largely responsible for the price dip in Oregon farm prices, Mrs. Horrell said. Potato prices in April, averaging less than half those of a year ago, also held down the Oregon price index. However, Oregon farm prices still average 2 percent higher than a year ago.
 Meantime farm costs throughout the nation moved up during April for a record high as labor and operation costs and farm family living costs continued to rise. During the last year, farm costs have out-paced farm prices. This has put the buying power of farm products in a squeeze.
 At the same time, factory wage earners had a more favorable buying power than a year ago with hourly wages up 5 percent during the past year and only a 4 percent increase in prices of goods and services city workers buy.
