—Girl Hot-Rodder Builds Own Racing Car



Grace Curry, Miss Autorama of 1956, checks her "Doodlebug" which she races Sundays down the drag strip at Woodbine, N. J. Capable of hitting 120 miles per hour, the car is a custom-made model, built by Grace herself. Here she checks over the wheel lugs for proper tightness with an Ingersoll-Rand Torque Control Impactool. First and only electric torque control wrench in the world with optional Torsion Bar Torque Control, the tool automatically spins down nuts to a preset torque and then shuts itself off. If the nut is tight enough, the tool will not operate. A hybrid of many parts, the "Doodlebug" has a Mercury '48 engine, Offenhauser heads and a 2-pot manifold. It is built on a '40 Ford frame, and runs on '35 Ford wheels. The hand-formed aluminum body has Pontiac taillights set in reversed Studebaker truck fenders.
