A Luxury Pie The Easy Way



Here's a streamlined version for that most elegant of pies—Nesselrode—originally concocted by Count Nesselrode's chef. Cherry-studded and rum-flavored, this unusual and delectable dessert is no trouble to make with a package of vanilla pudding and pie filling mix. It's a perfect dessert for holiday entertaining and so easy to attain.

1 package vanilla pudding and pie filling mix	2 tablespoons sugar
2 teaspoons gelatin	1/4 cup whipping cream
Dash of salt	1 tablespoon chopped maraschino cherries
2 cups milk	1/4 teaspoon rum extract
1 egg yolk	1 baked 9-inch pie shell
1 egg white	Baked pastry cut-out and pecans

Combine pie filling mix, gelatin, salt, and 1/4 cup milk in saucepan. Add egg yolk and blend well. Add remaining 1-3/4 cups milk. Cook and stir over medium heat until mixture comes to a full boil. Remove from heat.

Beat egg white until foamy throughout. Add sugar, a tablespoon at a time, and continue beating until meringue will stand in peaks. Then fold in hot filling gradually. Chill, stirring occasionally. Whip cream and fold with cherries and rum extract into pudding mixture. Pour into pie shell. Chill. Decorate top with a small baked pastry cut-out and circle of pecan halves.
