At the same works a certain number of days it is not necessary to pay the social security tax on her Wages. Is this correct?

A: No.A domestic worker's vate home is covered if the amount is \$50 or more in a calendar quarter. The number of days is immaterial. At \$6.50 At \$6.50 a week and 13 weeks to a quarter, it looks as if you should be reporting your employee's wages to the Internal Revenue Service. You should contact that office immediately.

Q: How soon after the close of the quarter must an employer report the wages paid to household workers?

A: The tax neport must be filed with the District Director of Internal Revenue during the month following the close 01 the quarter. For example, wages paid during the 3-mnnth period ending June 30 must be reported by July 31.

Q: What is the reasoning behind witholding Old-Age and Survivors insurance monthly benefits of the beneficiaries earn more than \$1200 a year?

A: Old-Age and Survivors in surance is intended to replace part of the familys income when the breadwinner dies, retires or is disabled. The earnings test is to assure that benefits will be paid only to persons who have ubstantially retired or to deendents who do not have sub-
