(By John J. Inskeep, County Farm families who have farmed the same land continu-ously for a hundred years or more will be honored at State Fair coming up by the Oregon State Department of Agriculture headed by Robert J. Steward. The first claimant to this distinction coming our attention incude descendants of the late George Washington Jackson. Sr. living in the Glad Tidings Community be tween Molalla and Marquam. Coming to our office recently with documents to support their claim were Mrs. Gladys Long and Mrs. Esther Wilbroad, granddaughters of George Washington Jackson, Sr. The other grandchild is Carl Jackson, a brother.Families of these three are still farming a portion of the original donation land claim petitioned by George W. Jackson, Sr. Cet 1, 1849. In

evidence also was the patent signed by President Buchanan about 10 years later. George Washingtin Jackson Sr. was born in Easton, Pa.May 10, 1825. At the age of 12 he was sent to Illinois where was apprenticed to a tanner.He came to Oregon as we recollect from th evidence in 1847. Later he returned to Pennsylvan-

He returned shortly to Oregon by way of Panama. The donation land claim included a section of 640 acres in town ship 5 south ,1 sec. Here started farming and raised a fa-mily of 14 children if whom George Washington Jackson Jr. Mrs. Lang was the youngest. Mrs. Wilbroad and Carl Jack-sor are his descendants.

George Washington Jackson Sr. was a man of parts. In addition to farming, he taught grade school, singing and danc-ing. He is the author of a pioeer song and his descendants have the original cipy written by his hand. For one winter at least, he taught the Bald Hill school near the present Jacob

Schnack place. Evidently in those days, and much later, funds raised by assessment were not sufficient for paying a good shool teacher. Is this instance seven of the neighbors signed an agreement to pay their teacher \$100 quarter of three quarters. WANTED: To buy all kinds signers were Charles N. Vandervort, H. F. Kaylor, Levi Davis Wm. Broughton, Esther Todd John Wilhoit and James O. All the signees wrote good hands but the latter signature was faded and we cannot

be too sure of it.

The elder Jackson belonged to the Masonic lodge. He was appointed Glad Tidings Postmister in 1860. He opereated a small tannery on Rock Creek and was active in military af-In fact he was appoint ed Colonel of the second regiment of the territorial militia August 1, 1856 by B. F. Hard ing acting governor.

Pioneers were not without social diversions. Among the documents owned by the elder Jackson's descendants is the copy of an invitation to a party (Continued on Page 3)

OREGON LEADS IN

LUMBER PRODUCTION States during 1956 totalled 37.7 billion board feet according to the latest estimate by the Bureau of Census. SURVIVAL STOCKPILE

ODCM Has Vast Supplies In 'Bank' If U. S. Is Hit

One of the nation's largest "bank accounts" against the possibility of enemy attack is the Office of Defense and Civilian Mobilization's stockpile of strategic materials.

Stored away in 43 ODCM ware-houses across the United States are about \$225,000,000 worth of medical and engineering supplies —enough to aid millions -enough to aid millions Americans after an attack.

MEDICAL STOCKPILES include 1,932 civil defense emer-gency hospital units and back-up supplies estimated sufficient for the emergency medical care of th

In the engineering stock-piles are approximately \$5,000 tons of equipment and supplies. They contain mate-rial essential to rectoration of public facilities—water

pumps, generators, purifiers, storage tanks, pipe and similar items.

To assure that this survival "hardware" will be located where it would be most needed

Among these storage sites are three "general reserve" ware-houses with stockpiles designed to supply any section of the country. Most unusual of these reserve storage areas is the vast verted limestone mine near
