COAST GUARD ENTRANCE
EXAMS FEB. 24 AND 25, '59

Representative Walter Norblad (R-Ore.) today announced that the competitive examination for entrance to the U.S. Coast Guard Academy will be held nationwide on February 24 and 25, 1959. These examinations will be given in 118 cities.

"There are no appointments or geographical quotas for entrance to the Coast Guard Academy," he said. "I urge all qualified young men who are interested in a worth while profession to write for details and applications as soon as possible to me at 1128 House Office Building, Washington 25, D. C. Applications must be postmarked on or before January 15th."

A candidate for the next examination for the Coast Guard Academy must be single, must have reached his 17th but not his 22nd birthday by July 1, 1959 and must be in excellent physical condition.

A high school diploma is the minimum educational requirement, although high school seniors assured of being graduated by June 30 are eligible to take the examination if they have at

YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY

Q: My husband and I have been separated for about 10 years. I recently heard he had passed away. Am I eligible for benefits?

A: Since there was no divorce, you will be eligible to receive monthly benefits at age 62 if your husband had worked long enough under Social Security to qualify, and if you are not working and earning more than \$2080 during a year, and not receiving Social Security checks based on your own work which would exceed your widow's payment. Since you were not living together, the lump-sum death payment must be paid to whomever pays his burial expenses.

Q: Is there a simple method for estimating Social Security payments for workers who have been covered under Social Security for several years and will retire in the next few years?

A: You, or anyone who is interested in the amount of your bene-

fit at this time or in the future, should contact the Social Security office and request a recently published booklet on Estimating Benefits.

Q: I represent a firm trying to locate one of our former customers. He receives Social Security and I wonder if you might give us the address where the checks are being mailed?

A: Our records are CONFIDENTIAL and we cannot disclose to unauthorized person any information concerning a particular beneficiary.
