**SOIL BANK SIGNUP
DECLARED HEAVY**

From all indications Clackamas
County will be the scene of a
large signup in the 1959 soil con-
servation reserve program. The
A.S.C. office was swamped with
callers interested in the program
on the first day of the informa-
tional signup September 2. There
are other indications of keen in-
terest including many inquiries
directed to A. S. C. and Exten-
sion workers. One A. S. C.
board member reported 25 calls
on the subject labor day weekend.
Following are some of the
questions asked by these callers
and the answers to them:

Question: What is the produc-
tivity index?
Answer: The productivity index
represents the County ASC Com-
mittee's estimate of the produc-
tive capacity of any one farm
compared to the average produc-
tivity of all non-irrigated land in
the county. The maximum amount
of annual ease or payment the
government is willing to make
for soil bank acres on any one
farm is based on the productivity
index.

Question: Does the government
represented by the ASC office
make an offer to lease my farm
for placement in the Soil Bank,
in part or all of it?
Answer: No. The individual
farmer offers to lease to the gov-
ernment at a certain price. Of-
fers above rates shown by the
productivity index will be auto-
matically rejected.

Question: Can I make an offer
to lease my place in whole or in
part below the figures represent-
ed by the productivity index?
Answer: Yes. In case there are
more offers than money the lower
offers will be accepted but not
the higher ones.

Question: After obtaining the
original form from the A.S.C. of-
fice between Sept. 2 and Oct. 3
am I under any obligation to of-
fer a portion or all of my tillable
land to the Soil Bank?
Answer: Absolutely not. The
information received are for you
to take home and study. In fact,
no contract will be accepted pri-
or to October 3.

Question: After offering a lease
agreement may I change it?
Answer: No, the first offer on
your part is final for the pro-
gram beginning in 1959. There
will be no arbitration or adjust-
ment.

Question: Can I obtain help
in properly filling the initial papers
and the final contract?
Answer: Yes. Trained person-
nel will be available at the A.S.
C. counter for this purpose.

Question: Will signing of a
contract for participation in the
1959 conservation soil bank re-
serve affect conservation re-

Answer: No. Nor will the
rate of payment of previously
signed contracts be affected.

Question: How long will Soil
Bank contracts run?
Answer: In case of a previous-
ly established cover, 3 years.
When a new cover is established,
a minimum of 5 years, a maxi-
mum of 10 years at your discre-
tion at time of signing the con-
tract. The 5 and 10 year pro-
gram applies to forest tree plant-
ings as well as to establishment
of grass cover.

Question: Are previously es-
tablished grasslands eligible for
lease to the government under
the 1959 Soil Bank program?
Answer: Under certain condi-
tions. Older than 5 year plantings
are acceptable provided they have
been taken, at least once, during
the previous two years. Plantings
made after 1953 are acceptable
provided the planting in question
was made on an area in the farm
tillable rotation prior to the
planting.

Question: Will nontillable land
be accepted in the new conserva-
tion reserve?
Answer: No. The land must
have been in recent cultivation.

One of the objectives of this pro-
gram is to reduce total crop
yield as an aid to reducing sur-
pluses.

Question: Is the planting of
Christmas trees acceptable un-
der this program?
Answer: Yes, provided there
is no harvest as long as the con-
tract is in effect.

Question: In what way can I
utilize the land which I may
have contracted under the soil
bank?
Answer: Forest tree planting is
suggested especially on part
time farms. Liberal cost sharing
is provided for planting either
trees or permanent ground cover.
When reforesting what better
can one ask than rental payment
for 10 years during which trees
are unproductive?

Question: What happens to my
contract with the government in
case the land in question changes
ownership?
Answer: The original owner
must return all rental monies to
the government, unless the new
owner takes over the contract.
This is allowable.
