W. L. Close, federal-state supervisor, said most of the shrinkage was in fresh pear line.From Juy through September 1232 cars of fresh pears were shipped from Oregon as compared with 1919 during the same period in 1957.

Total shipments in the first quarter of the shipping point year (July through September) from Hood River are only about one-third of last year'ss total for the same period.

Close said an unusually high amount of platform inspections for canneries were made during September including 2.2 million pounds of pears at Hood River and 19.8 million pounds of pears and 808,000 pounds of prunes at Medford.

Onions shipped during Septem-ber from Malheur county are of the finest quality and size shipped from that area in a long time, Close said.
