**NUT GROWERS TON ACRE NUT CLUB TO CONTINUE**  
R. L. Smith, County Agent, called it to the attention of Clackamas County Walnut and Filbert growers that the Nut Growers Society of Oregon and Washington is continuing "The Ton Acre Nut Club" in 1958, according to information received from Gordon Hull, Salem, President. This project was started in 1956 to "to foster, encourage and call attention to those practices that will increase production and promote the general welfare of the walnut and filbert industries in Oregon, Washington and British Columbia."

Rules and purposes and application blanks for membership in the "TPA Nut Club" may be obtained from county extension agents, nut processors or buyers. Smith stated that a grower to be eligible for the "Ton Per Acre Nut Club" must have a minimum of five acres of walnuts, filberts; a combination of the two or a nut crop interplanted with other tree crops. Yields must be reported from the entire bearing walnut and/or filbert acreage in a farm unit. Production must be at least 2000 pounds of walnut or filberts per acre dry weight (orchard run) whether a solid planting or interplanted with other crops. The dry weight per acre is based on the state standards which allow a 10 percent maximum moisture content.

Major headings on the application blanks include soil data, information on planting stock, pruning practices, fertilizer program, tillage practices, filbert suckering methods, pest control program, irrigation (if used) and harvest methods. Growers will also be asked to list other practices which they believe contribute to high average yields.  
Production must be verified by processing company or buyer and the application blank must be returned to the county extension agent.
