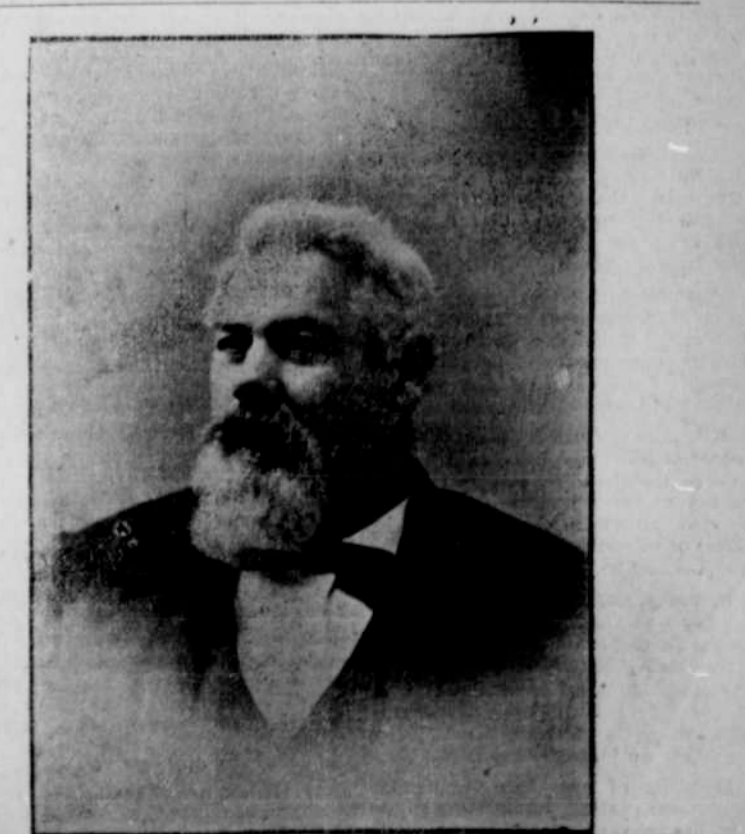
Dr. Hovey, Dentist, over Hibbs' new store.
