True, new blood is to be desired, especially as it comes though the pure bred dairy sire. But much can be accomplished without waiting for a new herd to grow up.

Seldom will any man sell good cows. The buyer has to take culls or pay a price which places good cows beyond his reach. Much valuable time is lost in buying and selling. In the endeavor to get a few good ones, bred from the best cows only; test them to find out just what they are doing; raise the heifer calves from the best cows and, when old enough, breed them in turn to a sire strong in dairy blood. In this way, any man can have a herd in a few years that will be a credit and that will make for him a profit.

Observe every animal in the herd with a critical eye; brush the dirt and scurf out of the matted hair and see if it hasn' got an udder capable of being stretched by more milk. Offer extra feed, and if she eats it clean, volunteer more Provide all on the pure water she will drink.
