Ordinance No. 166.

An ordinance to establish the elevations of the grade line of the main track of the railroad of the Oregon Electric Railway Company...

THE CITY OF FOREST GROVE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. The following elevations of the Oregon Electric Railway Company's main track (top of rail), intersecting the center lines of the streets hereinafter named, in the city of Forest Grove, Oregon, be and are hereby adopted...

Intersection of the center line of Oregon Electric Railway Company's main track and the center line of First avenue north or north First avenue, 179.22 feet above sea level datum...

Intersection of the center lines of said Railway Company's main track and Third street, 180.60 feet above said Railway Company's datum...

Intersection of center lines of said Railway Company's main track and Pacific avenue, 182.20 feet above said Railway Company's datum...

Intersection of the center lines of said Railway Company's main track and Second street, 182.12 feet above said Railway Company's datum...

Intersection of center lines of said Railway Company's main track and First street, 184.39 feet above said Railway Company's datum...

Intersection of center lines of said Railway Company's main track and Council street (on First avenue), 186.11 feet above said Railway Company's datum...

Intersection of center lines of said Railway Company's main track and Second street, 182.12 feet above said Railway Company's datum...

Railway Company's main track and Main street, 187.80 feet above said Railway Company's datum, or 213.02 feet above said basis or datum used by the city of Forest Grove.

Intersection of center lines of said Railway Company's main track and "A" street, 192.70 feet above sea level or datum as determined and established by said Oregon Electric Railway Company, or 217.92 feet above said basis or datum used by the said city of Forest Grove.

Section II.

The basis or datum used by the city of Forest Grove and referred to in this ordinance is 239.00 feet below the main door-step of Marsh Hall facing the postoffice, while the corresponding Oregon Electric Railway Company's sea level datum is 213.78 feet below the same point.

Section III.

It being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city of Forest Grove that the main track of said Railway Company's railroad shall remain at its present elevation in order that the public may with safety cross said railroad track, and the said Railway Company being desirous of commencing the operation of its said railway line on or before the 31st day of December, 1908, and for said reasons it is therefore necessary that said ordinance shall become immediately operative, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and become operative immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

Passed the common council of the city of Forest Grove, Oregon, on the 22 day of December, 1908.
