"Representatives of the districts that entered displays were on the ground with photographs, statistics and conservative word pictures of the exact state of things in the pomological history of the valleys and bench lands in Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana and British Columbia. They told their stories in a convincing way and were ready to answer all questions as to climate and soils.

"No one is in a position to foretell the extent of the influx of capital and settlers into the Northwestern country as a direct result of the apple show, but if only one of every hundred men and women who evinced interest in what this country offers to the homeseeker crosses to the west side of the Rocky mountains, the value of the Chicago exposition will be apparent on all sides.

"Some might infer that this widespread talk about apples and apple lands is entirely due to the Spokane and Chicago shows. That is not true; it is too general to make such claims. However, they confirmed the reports given in print and by word of mouth of the marvelous development of the apple industry and the rapid and substantial strides made in the Northwest during the last 10 years, and as such they proved their value a thousand-


