

"Music lovers in Portland and throughout Oregon will be pleased to hear of the advancement which Oswald Olsen, of Cornelius, is making in Dresden, under the direction of Leo Charles Sparks and Franz H. Armbruster. During the summer of 1909, while Mr. Sparks was spending his vacation in this city Mr. Olsen asked to have his voice tested. In the midst of the vocal examination Mr. Sparks arose from his piano and said, 'I must have that voice, you must return with me to Germany for training.
