PREPARING THE PEAR

MANY DIFFERENT WAYS OF COOKING FRUIT.

Splendid Dish When Stewed, but Many Variations in Serving Are Possible—Pear Dumplings Always a Welcome Delicacy.

The possibilities of pears, which are now in season, are apt to be overlooked by many cooks whose only idea in connection with this favorite dessert fruit is a dish of stewed pears. Hard green pears that are unfit for eating raw will do for a compote. Make a sirup of sugar and water and into this put the pears, which should be peeled and halved. Flavor the sirup with a small piece of vanilla bean or a few cloves and color a pretty pink with a few drops of cochineal. Stew the fruit until tender. Strain and reduce the sirup, which should be poured over the pears just before sending the compote to table.

A compote of pears is the basis of pear meringue. Whisk the whites of eggs to a stiff froth and add powdered sugar in the proportion of a tablespoonful of sugar to one white of egg. Spread the meringue over the compote and bake until the meringue is a pale brown.

Pear dumplings are popular with those who know this delicacy. The pear, which is peeled and cored, is wrapped in a light pastry and baked like apple dumplings. For pear fritters the batter should be rich, the addition of a little cream being a great improvement.

Pears a la marquise make a dainty dish. Cook a cupful of rice in two cupfuls of milk, with a tablespoonful of sugar, the grated rind of half a lemon and a teaspoonful of butter. Thicken with the yolks of two eggs well beaten, fill a buttered border mold and bake for ten minutes. Turn out on a serving dish, fill the center with stewed pears sprinkled with sugar and cover with sweetened whipped cream and serve.

For spiced pears wash one-half peck of Seckel pears, prick with a fork and cook in boiling water, to cover, until soft. Take out carefully, put in a stone jar and pour over the following sirup: Mix one pound of white sugar, one and one-half cupfuls of vinegar and one and one-half tablespoonfuls each of whole cloves and stick cinnamon, broken in pieces. Bring to the boiling point and let simmer three minutes. Cover jar and let stand two days. Drain off sirup, bring to the boiling point, let simmer three minutes and pour over fruit; repeat. In the jar keep a muslin bag in which are tied two tablespoonfuls each of whole cloves and stick cinnamon.

Apple Dumplings.

Three apples, rather tart, pare, halve and core. Crust: two cups of flour, one heaping teaspoon baking powder, pinch of salt, two heaping tablespoons fresh lard or butter, sweet milk to make a dough. Sift flour, baking powder, and salt together, cut in shortening, and with a mixing spoon stir in the milk. Roll to about one-fourth inch thickness and wrap each half of apple and place in rather deep pan. Take four cups of sugar, one tablespoon flour, one tablespoon butter, and nutmeg to flavor; mix together and add one quart boiling water, stirring while adding, then pour over dumplings in pan and bake one-half to three-quarters of an hour in rather hot oven. Baste with the sauce around dumplings when half done and let bake a nice brown. Serve with cream, either whipped of plain. These are splendid.

Cream of Tartar Biscuits.

One quart flour, 2 teaspoons cream tartar, 1 of soda dissolved in milk, little butter rubbed in the flour, milk enough to mix. Stir with a knife, then knead, roll and cut.

Apricot Bavarian Cream.

Cover a half box of gelatine with a half pint of cold water and let soak a half hour. Press a pint of fresh apricots through a colander, first stewing and sweetening to taste. Stir the gelatine over boiling water until dissolved. Whip a pint of double cream to a stiff froth. Add the gelatine to the apricots, mix and turn into a tin pan. Stand the pan in another filled with cracked ice and stir constantly until it begins to thicken. Add the whipped cream and stir until thoroughly mixed.

Mock Angel Food.

Sift four times: One cup sugar, one cup flour, three teaspoons baking powder, pinch of salt. Add to the above one cup of milk heated to boiling point. Beat well, add flavoring, then put in white of three eggs beaten stiff. Fold, but do not stir eggs in. Bake in regular angel food cake tin (kind with hole in center) until it does not adhere to broomstraw. Have oven very hot until cake has risen, then cool it by degrees until cake is done. Leave in pan and turn at once upside down to cool.
