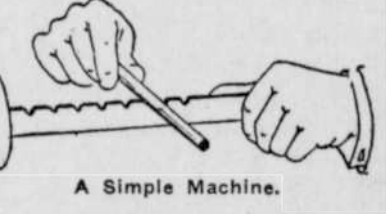
**COASTING.**

**SIMPLE MACHINE FOR BOYS**

Take a short piece of lath and cut some notches in the edge with a penknife. Then cut out a little disk of stiff card, color it if you like and stick it on the end of the lath with a stout pin.

Now hold the end that is further from the disk with your left hand and rub a penholder or a round pencil up



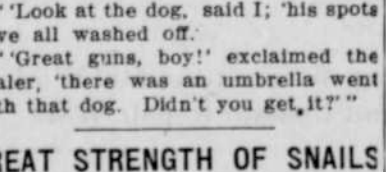

**Governors and Their Salaries.**  
In Alabama a futile effort has just been made to raise the salary of the governor from \$5,000 to \$7,500. Alabama is one of the 16 states that pay their governors \$5,000 a year. There are three states that pay only \$4,500. There are seven in which the salary is \$4,000 and eight that pay \$3,000. Wyoming, Vermont and Nebraska think that \$2,500 is enough for a governor. There are 13 states that pay salaries higher than \$5,000, the range being from \$6,000 to \$12,000. Only one state, Illinois, pays the latter amount. Five states, including New York, pay \$10,000 each. Alabama is one of the leading commonwealths in the \$5,000 group. Colorado, Florida, Oregon and Idaho are others in this group. The governors of Alaska and Hawaii, both appointive, get \$5,000 a year each, while the governor of Porto Rico gets \$8,000.
