Ye patriots of the land,
All ye who love your country,
Against saloons should stand.
Be bold against this traffic,
Your country's greatest foe;
Let word and deed and ballot
Proclaim, saloons must go.It is a fact of statistics that
out of every one hundred men
who reform, ninety return to
those habits again; while of
every one hundred boys and
girls who sign the pledge ninety
remain true to it through life.
It is also an established fact that
two-thirds of the Loyal Temper-
ance Legion children stand in
the front ranks at school for
scholarship and good deport-
ment.Of the more than one hundred
prominent leaders in the temper-
ance conference gathered recent-
ly seventy per cent of them
testified to receiving their tem-
perance conviction before they
were fifteen years of age.A leading feature of the
twentieth century effort of the
national W. C. T. U. is the Fran-
cis E. Willard Memorial organiz-
ing fund. This fund was first
established at the St. Paul na-
tional convention in 1898, for the
extension of the work to which
Miss Willard gave her life.What is the Woman's Chris-
tian Temperance Union? It is
an organization of women band-
ed together for the protection of
the home, the abolition of the
liquor traffic and the triumph of
Christ's golden rule in custom
and in law. It is the lineal de-
scendant of the great Woman's
Temperance Crusade of 1873-'74.
In Dec. 1873 under the inspira-tion of a temperance address by
Dr. Die Lewis, of Boston, the
women of Hillsboro and other
Ohio towns, were moved to con-
certed action against the saloon.
They gathered in the streets to
pray and marched two by two in-
to the saloons. They besought
the men who drank to cease to
do so, and the men who sold
liquor to give up the business,
and invited all to accept christ.
In fifty days this whirlwind of
the Lord had swept the liquor
traffic out of two hundred towns
and villages.The National W. C. T. U. of
the United States was organized
in November 1874 at Cleveland,
Ohio. It is the largest organiza-
tion composed exclusively of wo-
men and conducted by them.
Men are admitted as honorary
members.The noontide hour of prayer is
when each white ribboner the
world over is expected to lift her
heart in prayer for his blessing
on our work and workers and for
the overthrow of the liquor sys-
tem and its allies.The most pressing needs of
the W. C. T. U. is money to
carry on the work along its vari-
ed lines, and consecrated hearts
to join our ranks. When every
christian woman shall wear the
white ribbon the day of victory
will be at hand. We plead with
christian women to join with us
heart and hand to protect and
sanctify the home, that woman-
hood and manhood in equal puri-
ty, equal liberty and peace may
climb to those blessed heights
where "there shall be no more
curse."The white ribbon recruits of
the W. C. T. U. are the little
children from birth to six years
of age, whose mothers promise
to train them in the principles of
total abstinence and purity,
which will prepare them to enter
