Section 2, Article 2 of the Constitution of the State which provides that every male citizen of the age of 24 years and upwards who has resided in the state during six months immediately preceeding such election, and every white male of foreign birth 21 years old and upwards who has resided in the United States one year and in the state six months immediately preceeding the election, and has declared his intention of becoming a citizen of the state was so amended as to permit women with similar qualifications to vote at the general election of the state which would include municipal elections.
