### MANIC WIELDS RAZOR WITH FATAL RESULTS

HILLSBORO MAN INJURED

Fred Lyons, Morphine Eater, is Subdued by James Kershaw in Hard Battle.

HILLSBORO, ORE., James E. Kershaw, a Hillsboro painter, was badly cut early Friday morning by a razor in the hands of Fred Lyons, an habitual user of morphine, transformed into a maniac by being deprived of the drug. Kershaw is confined to his bed with a deep cut in his right hand and a partially dislocated shoulder received during his attempt to subdue the madman. Lyons was sent to the asylum at Salem.

Lyons lived with his mother and sister in a residence near Second and Main streets, Kershaw being a roomer in the house. About three o'clock he was awakened by a noise at his bedroom door and opening it found Lyons, armed with a razor. The latter accused him of having secreted his drugs and demanded their return; saying he would kill Kershaw if he refused.

Kershaw attempted to pacify the crazed man, but was attacked and owes his life to the fact that he is a powerful man. The maniac made vicious slashes with the razor, and the severe wound sustained by Kershaw was received while attempting to catch and hold the hand that grasped it. Lyons was finally overpowered and held on a bed until help arrived, summoned by his mother, who ran in her bare feet across a street which is being paved, and on which there is nothing but loose rock.
