HILLSBORO, ORE., James E. Kershaw, a Hillsboro painter, was badly cut early Friday morning by a razor in the hands of located shoulder received during his attempt to subdue the madman. Lyon was sent to the asy-

Kershaw attempted to pacify the crazed man, but was attacked and owes his life to the fact that he is a powerful man. The maniac made vicious slashes with the razor, and the severe wound sustained by Kershaw was received while attempting to catch and hold the hand that grasped it. Lyon was finally overpowered and held on a bed until help arrived, summoned by his mother, who ran in her bare feet across a street which is being paved, and on which there is nothing but loose rock.


