

If a recipe says the sauce must be cooked stir in the grated horseradish It weakens it to cook horse-

Favorite Condiments.

Boiled Horseradish Sauce.-Melt a third of a cup of butter in a saucepan and stir a half cupful of flour in it. When this is hot pour in a pint of boiling milk and stir until it forms a smooth sauce. Let it boil for twenty minutes. Season with a pinch of cayenne, a half teaspoonful of salt and strain. Add two stalks of grated horseradish. If a boiled sauce is made stir in the horseradish last. Horseradish Sauce With Oil.-Take

two tablespoonfuls of grated horseradish, a tablespoonful each of vinegar, salad oil and ground mustard. Add a quarter of a tablespoonful of salt and
