SUNFLOWER SEED USE HOME-PLANNING IN COUNTRY

GIVEN COUNT AS POULTRY FEED BY PROFESSOR LIPPINCOTT.

Its Good for Molting Period, but Not Practicable at Other Times on Average Farm-Too Much Fiber and Too Expensive.

Sunflower seed because of its cost and high fiber content is not so desirable a poultry feed as is generally supposed, according to W. A. Lippincott, by trees, vines and shrubbery. professor of poultry husbandry in the Kansas State Agricultural college.



Whole Farm Layout Should Be Sketched and Studied Before Any Buildings Are Erected.

Put the house, if possible, on an eminence, or rise, facing east or south with a gentle slope away from the front. Don't build too near the road, nor yet too far back-150 to 250 feet will generally be about right.
