At the lower end a slide in the river has contracted the channel so that it is scarcely fifty feet wide. The first drift from above lodged there and held all the rest till now the river is clogged for a distance of about 6 miles above. This immense obstruction will stay there unless loosened and worked out by human hands during the high water that usually comes in March. The matter really requires prompt attention. A summer's neglect will solidify loess and wash so that when it is moved, as it ultimately must be, the expense will be increased over what it would be now.
