There is something of a dead lock between the allies and Chinese at Pekin. The United States objects to some of the propositions and has suggested to Great Britain to join in carrying the point.

Dunn the Oregonian correspondent at Washington reports very minutely how Oregon appropriations have been scaled by the senate committee on finance, but does not state that the appropriations for all other states have also been scaled.

Territorially Oregon is a big state. The population is 418,536, that of a small state. The legislature makes large appropriations in imitation of New York, Ohio and Illinois.

The INDEPENDENT last week accepted as true the report of the vote on the Poorman's law servant bill as published in the Oregonian of the 14. The report was not correct.

There is no statement more true than this paragraph from the St. Louis Globe-Democrat: "This country has no ports in Alaska or elsewhere to dispose of. If the building of the Nicaragua Canal, in British estimation, depends upon a trade of that kind, the people of the United States will terminate the Clayton-Bulwer treaty by a method not entailing the loss of territory."

The Oregonian always long on headlines, has in Tuesday morning's issue these words in a prominent column first page "McBride Not There. Senate Commerce Committee cut down Oregon items in River and Harbor bill."

The United States is finding that alliances are not desirable. We were forced to act with the allies in China last summer but drew out as quickly and as far as possible with the army when the legations were relieved, but diplomatically we have worked with the Europeans. Now the Germans want to organize a great expedition to go into the interior of the empire.

There were some in Oregon who thought our delegation in Congress and especially Mr. Tongue was not doing the fair thing by the Indian war pension bill, and that they could do better if they were there. The legislature appropriated \$3000 and sent a committee back of which T. A. Wood is chairman and Wait of Salem a member or ought to have been.

Some of the European governments foster beet sugar raising by paying a bounty on the product. Our government imposes a duty on imported sugar because it comes in competition with a domestic industry, and on sugar coming from a bounty giving country an additional duty is levied.
