PROTECTIVE TARIFF OR EXCISE TAX.

The complex systems of government demanded by modern civilization require money for their maintenance.

There are two general plans for national taxation—laying duties on imports of merchandise or imposing an excise tax on domestic productions.

The American idea is to employ a system of duties that is least burdensome to the people and one that will protect home industries.

The English system of excise taxation is laid to produce the greatest revenue regardless of protection or weight of burden to be borne by the people.

For producing revenue, a few standard articles are taken, spirits and tobacco in both countries, to which England adds tea, sugar, coffee and some other articles most used by the mass of the people.

The United States keeps it off those articles, electing rather to put a duty on imports that come in competition with home products, raw or finished.

This coffee and tea are on the free list, though a war tax of 10 cents per pound, pure excise tax, is on tea.

On the other hand, the tax collected on tea, an article that has no domestic competition, is paid by the consumer, and the price of tea went up 10 cents per pound in 1898, when the war tax was laid.
